

NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 4/25

(Small Craft Notice)

River Wye - Brockweir

Obstructions – Brockweir Quay

Please be advised that water level gauges on steel posts have been installed by the Environment Agency as part of a flood warning scheme on the East bank at Brockweir Quay on the River Wye, just upriver from Brockweir bridge and the stone section of quay. Approximate position 51°42' 26.96N / 002°40' 8.73W

Three posts are installed in a line ascending the bank, with a green pole-mounted control box close to the top post. The lower two posts will be submerged during high water levels such as high tides or large volumes of freshwater outflow, with the lower post particularly being a potential hazard.



Vessels navigating close to the riverbank or attempting to moor in the vicinity are advised to proceed with caution and avoid the immediate area where the posts are installed. A warning sign will be installed in due course.
