

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 13 OF 2025

Hinkley Point C Marine Works Offshore Area – Aids to Navigation Maintenance

Issued: 13/08/2025

Please be advised that, during week commencing 18 August 2025, Navmoor, on behalf of Cefas, will service the Cefas waverider buoy in charted position 51°13.591'N 003°11.355'W (WRB on chart extract) utilising the vessel Veronica D. The operation will consist of removing the current buoy, tether and clump weight and replacing them with identical items. The operation should take no more than two hours.



VERONICA D (IMO 9136319, MMSI 235008011) is a Utility Vessel. Call Sign: **MWCI9**

During this operation, the vessel will be restricted in her ability to manoeuvre and will display the lights and shapes in accordance with the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea 1972 (as amended). Vessels within this area are requested to proceed with caution, reduce wash and maintain a safe distance.




Chart extract identifying the HPC Marine Works Area buoy locations.
